

Designed for polar research, the Akademik Sergey Vavilov is modern, comfortable, safe and ice-strengthened. There are public spaces on board the ships ideally suited for each and every need. A separate bar and lounge, as well as a library, provide ideal places to sit and relax or catch up on some reading. The vessel transit open water crossings with ease due to their speed and integrated internal ballast system, resulting in a tremendous reduction from severe rolling in heavy seas. As a result, it is the most stable vessel travelling to Antarctica. The spacious outer decks provide 360 degree views of the stunning landscapes.


